INSTRUCTIONS:

SELECT YOUR ENTRIES, DOWNLOAD, COMPLETE AND PRINT SCORE SHEETS:

The SCFMS will use the same categories and scoring system as AFMS. All Score Sheets for Bulletins, Junior Articles, Adult Articles, Advanced Adult Articles, Adult Poetry, Special Publications, and Features can be downloaded from the SCFMS Web site: http://www.scfms.net/editor_author_contest.htm or from the AFMS website: <http://www.amfed.org/editor/BEAC/contest.htm>. The forms are in PDF format and can be filled in, saved, and printed. Fill in **ONLY** the top section. The lower section is for SCFMS/AFMS judges. To edit the forms you will need Acrobat Reader, a free program which can be downloaded from the web at <http://www.adobe.com/products/reader/>. Some have also used CuteWriter to save filled forms as a PDF which can be downloaded at <http://www.cutepdf.com/products/cutepdf/Writer.asp>. Due to Adobe's transition to the cloud and subscription based service for Acrobat Pro, I highly recommend the latter. I would prefer not to mail the contest rules and entry forms. Please download and print this information from the SCFMS or AFMS Websites. However, if you do not have internet access or have difficulty accessing a printer, contact the SCFMS BEAC for hard copies. Links to the AFMS/SCFMS Score Sheet for each category are listed in the SCFMS contest Rules and Guidelines and a list can be found within "Tips for Editors". We follow the AFMS Specific Guidelines very closely, but our regional contest may differ slightly. These differences are pointed out in the SCFMS Guidelines and should not affect AFMS eligibility.

Please paperclip rather than staple the pages of your entries. Stapling creates a hardship for our judges who would prefer to quickly remove the scoring sheet and have it handy as they score.
